



VENDOR CODE OF CONDUCT

At the Salt Lake City Pride Festival, we are dedicated to fostering an environment that celebrates diversity, promotes inclusivity, and ensures the safety and well-being of all participants. As a vendor, you play a vital role in upholding these values. Please adhere to the following code of conduct:

1. Embrace Inclusivity and Respect:

- Embrace the diversity of our community and show respect to individuals of all backgrounds, including race, ethnicity, nationality, religion, gender identity, sexual orientation, disability, age, and more.
- Honor and affirm the identities and experiences of LGBTQIA+ individuals. Avoid language or behavior that may harm or exclude members of the LGBTQIA+ community.

2. Zero Tolerance for Harassment:

- Harassment, whether verbal, physical, or sexual, is strictly prohibited. Treat everyone with kindness, empathy, and consideration. Engage in respectful communication and interactions at all times.

3. Prohibition of Weapons:

- To ensure the safety of all attendees, the possession of weapons, including firearms, knives, or any other dangerous items, is strictly prohibited within the Salt Lake City Pride Festival premises.

4. No Degrading Behavior:

- Refrain from using language, actions, or displays that are derogatory, demeaning, or offensive to any individual or group. Avoid behavior that perpetuates stereotypes or promotes discrimination.

5. Treat Booth Neighbors and Patrons with Respect:

- Interact with your booth neighbors and patrons in a respectful and understanding manner.
- Be mindful of the space and boundaries of others. Collaborate and communicate effectively to ensure a harmonious festival experience for everyone.

6. Compliance with Laws and Regulations:

- Adhere to all applicable laws, regulations, and policies, including those related to health, safety, environmental protection of Salt Lake city, The Salt Lake City Festival and The Gateway.

7. Reporting Violations:

- If you witness or experience any behavior that violates this code of conduct, please report it immediately to Festival Leadership, the designated festival staff, or security personnel.

8. Consequences of Violations:

- Violations of this code of conduct may result in expulsion from the Salt Lake City Pride Festival premises and/or prohibition from participating in future festival events.
